Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Gangotri

- Altitude: 3,048m
- Explore Gangotri Temple
- Stay in Hotel

Day 2: Gangotri to Bhoj Kharak

- Altitude: 3,048m to 3,930m
- 8 kms trek, approx 6 hours
- Stay in tents

Day 3: Bhoj Khadak to Kedar Khadak

- Altitude: 3,930m to 4,410m
- 7 kms trek, approx 7 hours
- Stay in tents

Day 4: Kedar Khadak to Kedar Tal Parikrama Back to Bhoj Kharak

- Altitude: 4,410m to 4,859m
- 5 kms trek, approx 4 hours
- Back to Kedar Khadak 5 kms 3 hours
- Stay in tents

Day 5: Kedar Khadak to Patangini Dhar Base Camp

- Altitude: 4,410m to 4,160m
- 8 kms trek, approx 7 hours
- Stay in tents

Day 6: Patangini Dhar Base Camp to Rudugaira Nala Camp

- Altitude: 4,160m to 3,775m
- 5 kms trek, approx 7 hours
- Stay in tents

Day 7: Rudugaira Nala Camp to Gangotri

- Altitude: 3,775 to 3,048m
- Departure day

The fee can be paid by online transfer/Check deposit/Cash deposit/Demand draft.

Inclusions:-

1. Accommodation. (Guest house/Camping)
2. Meals while on trek (Veg.)
3. Equipments: Sleeping bag, mattress, tent , toilet tent, utensils
4. All necessary permits and entry fees.
5. First aid medical kits, stretcher and oxygen cylinder.
6. Mountaineering qualified & professional trek Leader, guide and Support staff.
7. Transport from Rishikesh/Dehradun and return
8. Mules to carry the central luggage

Exclusions:-

- Any kind of personal expenses.
- Food during the transit.
- Insurance
- Mules or porter to carry personal luggage.
- Anything not specifically mentioned under the head.
- Any kind of emergency evacuation charges.

Note : Charges of offloading backpack:- INR 1800/- The backpack cannot weigh more than 10 kgs.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations prior to 30 days from the start of the Trip

- a. Get 95% refund
- b. B. 100% cash voucher for any trip till one year

Cancellation between 30 days and 15 days to the start of the Trip

- Get 70% cash refund
- 100% cash voucher for same trip till one year
- 80% cash voucher for any trip till one year

Cancellation less than 15 days to the start of the trek
